## FOR RESPONDING TO A MOTION TO CHANGE CHILD CUSTODY, SUPPORT OR VISITATION

A Center facilitator can explain court procedure and give you forms for each part of the case, but cannot give you legal advice.
- **Court staff generally can talk to you about court procedure, court rules, court records, and forms. They must remain neutral and impartial. They cannot give legal advice. Court staff cannot tell you how rules and statutes apply to your case, if your documents properly present your case, what the best way is to accomplish your goal, or interpret laws for you.**
- **If you need help with your case**, you should talk to a lawyer. The Alaska Bar Association’s Lawyer Referral Service can give you names and phone numbers of lawyers who handle family law cases and those who are willing to provide limited legal services to clients who are representing themselves.
